## Volleyball All-Conference Selections

- Coaches will vote for the Player of the Year using a 3-2-1 vote procedure. Secret ballots will be used and coaches may not vote for their own player. The player with the most points will be the Player of the Year. Ties are voted off. If a second tie occurs, both players share the Player of the Year title.
- For First Team, coaches will nominate players and then vote using a 7-6-5-4-3-2-1 system. A secret ballot will be used and coaches may not vote for their own players. The seven players receiving the highest point totals will be First Team. If a tie for the seventh and final position should occur, the coaches vote on the two players. If a second tie occurs, both players are named to the first team.
- Following the First Team selection process, the same procedures are used to select seven Second Team members.
- A First Team and Second Team defensive specialist will start off the voting of each round.
- Coaches will conduct a secret ballot for Coach of the Year. Coaches may not vote for themselves.
- Each coach will have the opportunity to name two players as Honorable Mention honorees.
